



Golf Carts

With the growth in membership has come a growth in the number of golf carts in use at Bare Oaks. In order to ensure everyone's safety and enjoyment, we have created this golf cart policy.

Definition

The term golf cart includes all motorized vehicles that cannot legally travel on public roads. (vehicles that are used for transportation on Ontario roads cannot be used for travel within the park)

Power

To prevent environment and noise pollution, only electric powered golf carts are allowed.

Insurance

Golf carts must be insured and proof of current insurance must be on file at the office. Most trailer insurance will add coverage for your golf cart at minimal cost.



Operation

Golf carts are limited to traveling on the park roads. For everyone's safety and enjoyment, they are not allowed on the grass, beaches or walking paths.

Driving While Intoxicated

Driving a golf cart while intoxicated is just as dangerous for the driver, passengers and bystanders as it is in a car.

The same rules apply within the park as they do on public roads. (no open alcohol in the vehicle, no drinking and driving, etc...)

In August of 2009, a man was charged, by the police, with driving while intoxicated after he struck a 5-year-old girl. He was driving a golf cart in a private campground near Ottawa, Ontario.
